Leadership Team Updates:

Integration Coordinator Report: Lisa Masi reported:

- 1. Current enrollment is 133 students, enrollment will be offered from the waiting list. The 2025-2026 school year's enrollment is 135 students.
- 2. The March 19, 2025 Open House was well attended. Many new applications were received.
- 3. Passage Presentations will take place the weeks of May 19, 2025 and May 26, 2025
- 4. The school lunch program was discussed. Ms. Masi is still reaching out to local districts for interest in SFA to SFA program for next school year.
- 5. The graduation committee is continuing to explore ways to streamline the ceremony.
- 6. The current school year calendar needs to be updated due to unused snow days.
- 7. The Stardust and Galaxy students have been maple sugaring. The teams made a rocket stove to aid in the

sugaring process.

Infrastructure Coordinator Report: Traci Pannullo reported for Robin Balles:

- 1. The Land Care committee has been busy planning the Spring Garden Workshop. The committee is proposing that Spring Garden Workshop will begin the first week in May and run for five weeks, on Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays. Sign ups will be via a google form. The committee plans on a minimum of 3 guides to run the club and asked if a fourth guide could be added if needed.
- 2. An Americorp intern will be visiting the school to plant trees in early May.
- 3. A proposal from Bradley White, on behalf of the Land Care committee, was shared to plant a tree to memorialize Dave McNulty. Funds from the plant sale fundraisers will be used.
- 4. Community Service Day will not take place on April 12, 2025 but will be scheduled for April 9, 10, 11, & 16, 2025. Dates will have different times in order to accommodate parent schedules.
- 5. Hot water heaters were removed and replaced, per contract.
- 6. A new school intercom system will be installed.
- 7. The gutter on the Universe Building will be installed to improve operational efficiency.
- 8. Future facility planning has commenced.
- 9. Immediate facility needs are being addressed.

Curriculum Coordinator Report: Traci Pannullo reported:

- 1. The Cultivating Leadership Committee met via Zoom. It was discussed that working committee work can take place in the absence of a Trustee. This will aid in scheduling meetings during the school day.
- 2. The Hope Green Fair is taking place on April 26, 2025, 10am-2pm. The option to have a booth was discussed.
- 3. The next NJPCSA meeting is scheduled for March 27, 2025. This meeting will discuss changes in legislation on the State and Federal level.
- 4. An application to the NJ Green School, a national ranking, non-profit organization, was submitted. This will aid in connecting RVCS worldwide and provide international resources.
- 5. The Earth Charter application was submitted by M. Vetter. A copy of the presentation was shared.
